Playing with Fyre is a contra dance band from the Blue Ridge Mountain areas of NC and VA. PwF was founded on the magical and unique musical bond between Rob Zisette, fiddle and vocals, of Toss the Possum, and George Paul, piano, formerly of Avant Gardeners. The addition of Steve Kemble, percussion, puts their sound over the top. Rob's fiery fiddle playing, George's funky, bluesy piano, and Steve's extraordinary rhythm create an ambiance of dance seldom experienced.

Bob Isaacs, from New Jersey, has treated dancers across the US and Europe to his many creative dances, clear teaching, and spirited calling for many years. Whether he is calling flowing contras, hot squares, or his famous grid squares, dancers are sure to enjoy a dance that is different and fun.

THE VENUE

Lewis Ginter Recreation Association 3421 Hawthorne Ave, Richmond VA

Contra dances will be held on the sprung wooden dance floor of the second story Arents Music Hall of this beautiful century-old building in Ginter Park. Additional workshops, meals, and activities will be hosted on the lower level of this historic building, which was originally built as a school house and formerly served as a community hall.

Lodging is not available onsite. Ginter is just a 10 minute drive to the heart of downtown Richmond, with multiple nearby hotel and AirBnB options for various budgets. Limited host housing is available for early bird registrants. Housing is not guaranteed if requested after March 14.

Meals: Saturday box lunch can be preordered with your registration for an additional \$12. Saturday covered dish supper is included with registration at no additional cost. Local dancers are encouraged to bring a main dish. Out of town dancers are invited to bring a side dish. All Saturday attendees are welcome.
